Bullying will not be tolerated at Rhodes School.

Rhodes staff, students, parents, and community will be proactive in preventing bullying. Staff will be trained about bullying behavior specifically how to help prevent bullying and how to handle bullying when it occurs. Students will be educated on what bullying behavior looks like and what they can do to help prevent bullying. Parents and the community will be encouraged to be aware of bullying behaviors and discourage these behaviors from happening at home and in the community. Together the staff, students, parents, and community will help to make Rhodes School safe and bully free.

Bullying Behavior Defined

Bullying Definition:

Bullying is repeated exposure over time to intentional negative actions. Bullying is aggressive and can take many forms including verbal, psychological, physical and cyber bullying. Bullying is when one person or a group of people uses power in a willful manner with the aim of deliberately hurting another individual

Specific bullying behavior includes but is not limited to the following:

- Verbal Bullying: teasing, threats, harassing, name calling, mocking
- Psychological Bullying: exclusion, gossiping, controlling, intimidation
- Physical Bullying: inappropriate unwanted physical contact, intimidation through invasion of personal space
- Cyber bullying: verbal and/or psychological bullying occurring through technology and/or media such as text messages, email, and/or social networking
